If you're looking to escape the crowds and enjoy a real western experience, then Grand Teton Covered Wagon Cookout is for you! Our wagons will take you on a comfortable 20-minute ride through the splendor of Buffalo Valley. Your destination is an isolated aspen grove where you will experience one of the best rib-eye steak dinners this country has to offer. Topping off dinner is authentic cowboy entertainment that is sure to get your toe tapping before you take the scenic ride back to your car. You'll find that with Grand Teton Covered Wagon Cookouts, our groups are small and our steaks are big, just the way it should be in Wyoming.

The covered wagon cookout is offered every Monday through Saturday, from June 15 to September 1. Dinner rides leave promptly at 5:30 pm from the parking area and breakfast rides promptly at 8:00 am. Breakfast rides require a minimum of 20 people. The dining area is covered in case of inclement weather.

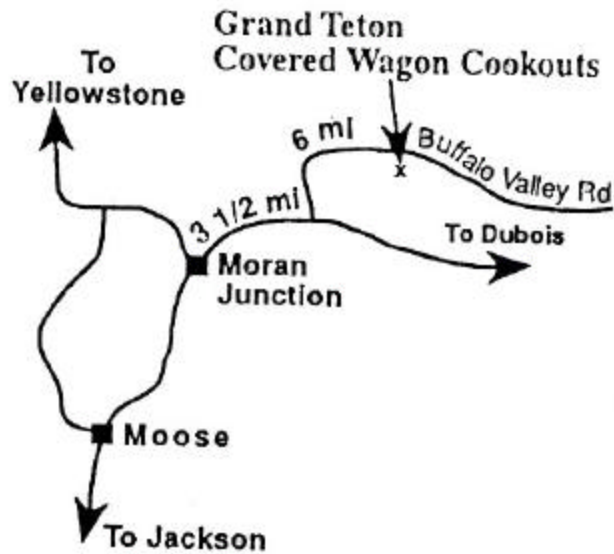

Other Activities:

Horseback Rides

All of our horseback riding trails allow you to experience the splendor and variety of terrain found in the Rocky Mountains. Come explore miles of trails climbing gently through sunlit evergreen forests to alpine meadows with spectacular views of wildflower-studded hillsides and the snow-capped peaks of the Tetons, Randolph Mountain, and Terrace Mountain. You can delight in fabulous views overlooking the Buffalo Fork of the Snake River and the Continental Divide. All of our horseback rides have great views, so please remember to bring your camera to help you capture this great experience.

All of our guides are experienced and knowledgeable of the areas history. Our horses are well trained and sure-footed. This is an excellent way to spend a few hours or days for individuals, couples, families, and large groups. Rides of various lengths are available for persons of nearly any age and ability; however, we recommend ages 5 and up for safety. If you or someone in your group has special needs, we will try to accommodate you. **Please wear shoes with a heel and long pants for your comfort and safety. We ask that you arrive 15 to 20 minutes before the scheduled time of your ride so that we can go over our safety rules.**

Two-hour rides: Leaves daily at 10:00 am and 2:00 pm for \$30.00 per person.

We have trails for all abilities. All can enjoy these rides.

All-day rides: 9:00 am to 5:00 pm for \$75.00 per person.

This popular ride travels into the Teton Wilderness Area. We provide a picnic lunch. Bring your camera and a jacket.

All-day fishing ride: 9:00 am to 5:00 pm for \$150.00 per person.

This trip takes about two hours of riding to the cold, clear lakes, streams, and creeks that can almost guarantee you excellent fishing for aggressive cutthroat and brook trout. All you need is your fishing gear, a Wyoming fishing license, and a jacket. We provide a picnic lunch. It'll be a day that's sure to be the subject of many fishing stories for a long time to come.
